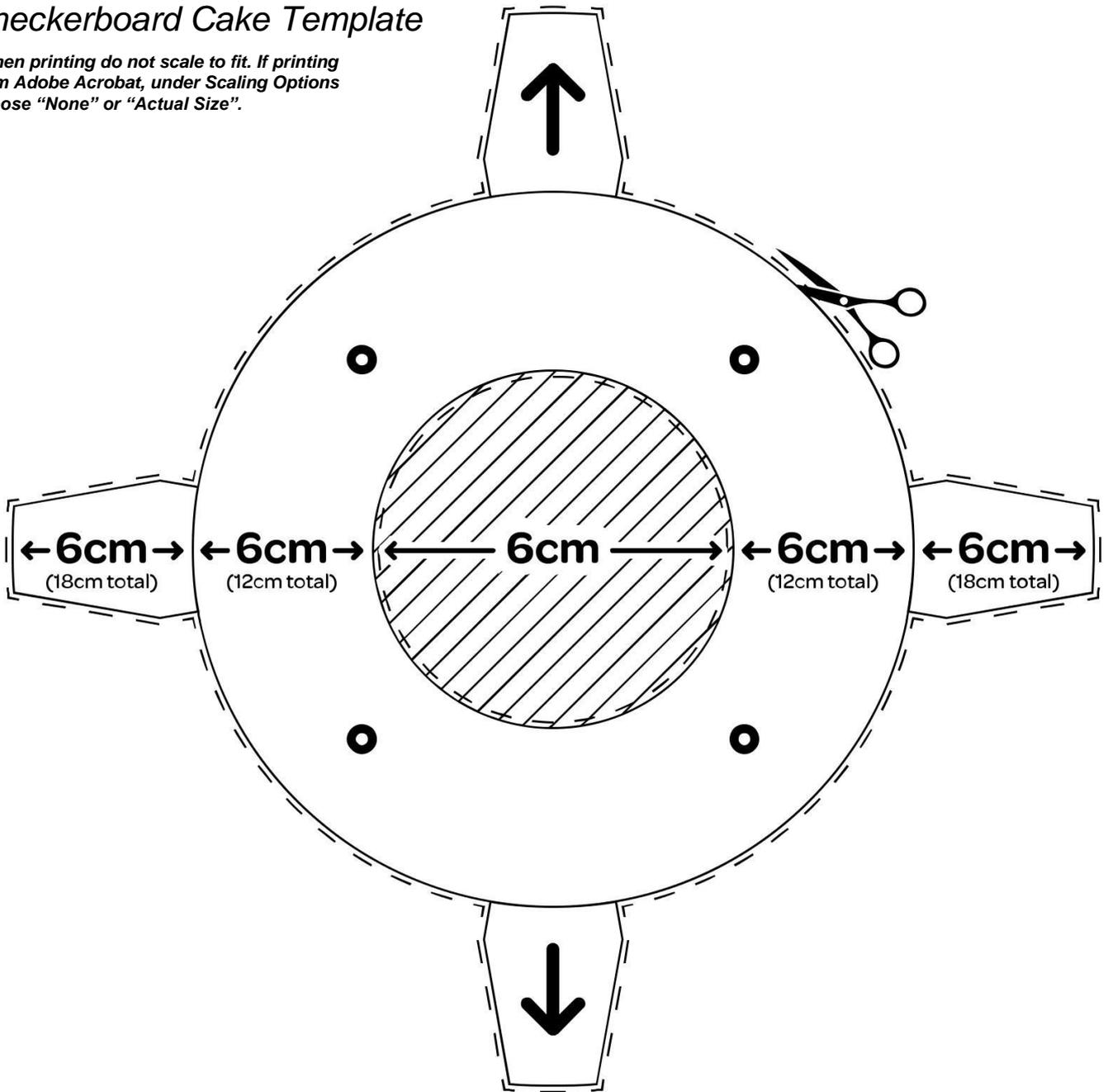




Checkerboard Cake Template

**When printing do not scale to fit. If printing from Adobe Acrobat, under Scaling Options choose "None" or "Actual Size".*



To assemble:

1. Print the cutting template OR make it by drawing on a piece of paper, copying the stencil image and dimensions.

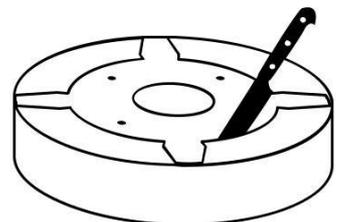
Cut out around the outer dotted lines where the scissor symbol appears on the template.

Be sure to cut out around the inner middle circle dotted lines.

2. You should now have a cake template with a 6cm inner ring, a 12cm centre ring attached with 4 small tab pieces so you can measure to the 18cm cake edge.

Hole punch the holes (shown in black).

3. Secure the template in the centre of one of the cakes by inserting toothpicks into the template holes into the cake; then using a small sharp knife and the template as a guide, carefully cut the cake into 3 rings.



Repeat with remaining cakes, using same template as a guide. (You should have 12 cake rings on completion including: 4 x 18cm rings, 4 x 12cm rings and 4 x 6cm rings of cake).

Follow the remaining recipe steps to assemble the cake layers for the final result.
